

Walkers can make donations in addition to walk registration fees, if desired.

- 1) Go to the walk website: http://walkforepilepsy.org/
 - 2) Select "Search/Log In" menu button from top right hand side of the screen
- 3) Under "Search Teams", type "Team EFVA" then select "Search" (Note that the team name includes the word "Team")
- 4) Select "Join" to sign up as either a walker or a virtual walker.
